GRADES 9 – 12 CLASS SCHEDULE

June 15 - July 17 2009

June 8 - June 26 (for OGT Prep classes)

The Board of Education has authorized the organization of a tuition summer school for students residing in the Cleveland Heights - University Heights City School District currently enrolled in grades nine through twelve. Information about summer school classes or enrollment is available from the Summer School Office daily from 1:30 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. Call 320-3183.

LENGTH OF SESSION: All Summer School classes, except OGT Prep classes, will begin on Monday, June 15, 2009. The last day of classes will be on July 17, 2009. The two-week Ohio Graduation Test (OGT) Prep classes will begin on Monday, June 8 and the OGT test will be administered June 22 – 26.

2nd Period : 10:10 A.M. - 12:35 P.M.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:

Register in person with a counselor at Cleveland Heights High School to receive approval on the following dates: May 18th through June 10th (Monday through Friday) from 1:30 P.M. - 4:00 P.M. in the appropriate Small School Office. (MS students entering grades 7 or 8 must meet with their MS counselor for course approval.) Submit the completed form with payment to the Main Office. Classes with registration of fewer than twenty students may be canceled. Classroom assignments will be posted in the main hallway on the first day of summer school.

Extended Registration Hours will be available on:

THURSDAY JUNE 11 10:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M.

FRIDAY JUNE 12 10:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M.

SATURDAY JUNE 13 10:00 A.M. - NOON

Extended registration will take place in the CHHS Main Office.

Registration closes at Noon on Saturday, June 13th. Late registration will be accepted until Tuesday, June 16th, with a \$25 late fee, on a space available basis.

OGT PREP CLASS REGISTRATION:

Registration for OGT Prep classes in summer school follows the same procedure as described above. Registration for OGT Prep classes closes on Friday, June 5 at 4:00 P.M. OGT Prep classes begin on Monday, June 8.

TUITION: The tuition charge established by the Board of Education is \$200.00 per individual course for residents of the school district. The tuition charge for an OGT Prep class is \$90.00 per course. Tuition is non-refundable and must be paid in advance. Tuition cost includes textbooks and most course materials. Students are typically required to provide general school supplies as required by the teacher (i.e. pens, pencils, paper, notebook, etc.).

PAYMENTS/REFUNDS: ONLY CASH OR MONEY ORDERS, MADE PAYABLE TO THE CLEVELAND HEIGHTS-UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS BOARD OF EDUCATION, WILL BE ACCEPTED. Payment of tuition in full is a requirement for registration. No refunds will be issued unless caused by our cancellation of a course. A late fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for students enrolling after June 13, 2009. Students registering after June 13 will be enrolled in classes only if space permits.

LOCATION: All classes for grades 9 through 12 will be held at Monticello Middle School.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation to and from Summer School is the responsibility of the parents.

ATTENDANCE: Attendance is MANDATORY. More than two (2) absences from a course for any reason will be grounds for dismissal from the program. The student will receive a letter grade of "FA" - Failure due to Absence; there will be no tuition refund. The material presented in the program is condensed, and classes move along rapidly. Pupils will have much longer daily assignments than during the school year. The State of Ohio High School Minimum Standard for course credit is sixty (60) clock hours of instructional time. If a student is absent from class more than twice, the student may remain in class until the end of the Summer School session. If the student has satisfactory attendance and fulfills the course requirements, the teacher may petition the Summer School Principal to remove the "FA" grade. A student is tardy when he/she arrives after the bell by less than twenty (20) minutes into class. After twenty (20) minutes, the student is considered absent for that class period.

GRADUATION

The Summer School Graduation ceremony will be Thursday, July 16, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. in the Cleveland Heights High School auditorium. Parents and students will be informed of specifics by mail.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS: All Board of Education and High School rules and regulations will be enforced during Summer School.

DRESS GUIDELINES: A student shall not dress or appear in a manner that interferes with the student's health and safety or that of other students or the education process of the school. The Principal or designee has the final word on the appropriateness of any clothing worn to school.
