**GRADES 6 – 8**

The Board of Education has authorized the organization of a tuition – based Summer School for students residing in the Cleveland Heights - University Heights City School District currently enrolled in grades six through eight. Information about Summer School classes or enrollment is available from the guidance counselor at each middle school. You may also contact Becky Quinn at 320-2021. **Middle school students enrolling in coursework for high school credit must enroll in the High School Summer School program. Information about the HS Summer School program is also available from the MS guidance counselor.**

**REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:**

**In order to register for MS and/or HS Summer School, students must meet with their guidance counselor to obtain approval to ensure coursework will meet promotion and/or graduation (HS courses) requirements. Register at Cleveland Heights High School (in person) on the following dates: May 18<sup>th</sup> through June 5<sup>th</sup> (Monday through Friday) from 1:30 P.M. - 4:00 P.M. in the Main Office. Completed forms must be returned with payment to the Heights High School Main office. Additional registration times (which may be more convenient) are as follows at Heights High (Main Office):**

**Registration closes at Noon on Saturday, June 13<sup>th</sup>. Late registration will be accepted until Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup> with the appropriate late fees (\$25), as space is available.**

In order to better serve all students within the Cleveland Heights-University Heights school district, select courses will be offered using computer-based curriculum.

**TUITION:** The tuition charge established by the Board of Education is \$85.00 per individual MS-credit course for residents of the school district. Tuition is non-refundable and payable in advance. It includes textbooks and most course materials. Students must provide paper, pens, pencils and notebook.

**PAYMENTS/REFUNDS: ONLY CASH OR MONEY ORDERS, MADE PAYABLE TO THE CLEVELAND HEIGHTS-UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS BOARD OF EDUCATION (CH-UH BOE) WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Payment of tuition in full is a requirement for registration. No refunds will be issued unless caused by cancellation of a course. A late fee of \$25 will be assessed for students enrolling in classes after June 13, 2009. Students will be enrolled as space permits.

**LENGTH OF SESSION:** Summer School will begin on Monday, June 15, 2009. The last day of classes will be on July 17, 2009. July 4<sup>th</sup> is a legal holiday, which will be celebrated on Friday the 4<sup>th</sup>. **Classes with registration of fewer than twenty students may be canceled.** There will be room assignments posted in the main hallway.

**LOCATION:** All classes for grades 6 through 8 will be held at Monticello Middle School.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation to and from Summer School program is the responsibility of the parents/guardians.

**ATTENDANCE: Attendance is MANDATORY. More than two (2) absences from a course for any reason will be grounds for dismissal from the program. The student will receive a letter grade of “FA” - Failure due to Absence. (There will be no tuition refund).** The material presented in the program is condensed, and classes move along rapidly. Pupils will have much longer daily assignments than during the school year. A student is tardy when he/she arrives after the bell by less than twenty (20) minutes into class. After twenty (20) minutes, the student is considered absent for that class period.

**STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:** For school policies see the Student’s Rights and Responsibility Handbook (Policy 5133). All Board of Education and MS School rules and regulations will be enforced during Summer School.

**DRESS GUIDELINES:** A student shall not dress or appear in a manner that interferes with the student’s health and safety or that of other students or the education process of the school. The Principal or designee has the final word on the appropriateness of any clothing worn to school.

**MIDDLE SCHOOL PROMOTION POLICY:** Board Policy 5123.1 states that “If a student earns a grade of “F” in one or two core courses at the end of the school year, the student will be required to attend and pass summer school in each of those courses.”
